

A Back-and-Forth Drawing Game for Kids

This drawing game for kids and adults is a fun and low-key way to pass the time, and connect, through creativity. You can play it at home, at the coffee shop, while waiting for food in restaurants, and in the doctor's office. Carry a small spiral note pad and pen in your purse, knapsack, or diaper bag to be ready at a moment's notice!

MATERIALS:

Paper

A pen or other drawing tool

INSTRUCTIONS:

One person starts the drawing with something simple and quick. For example, the first person might draw circle or a line, a pair of eyes, or the outline of a house.

Next, pass the page to the second person, and they add one thing to the drawing.

Then, just take turns adding elements back and forth. For added colour, give each person their own coloured pen for adding their elements.
