

DAY CAMP SAFETY EXPECTATION AGREEMENT

Dear Parent/Guardians:

The main goal of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury Community Services Department is to ensure that your child(ren) have a rewarding, memorable, safe and fun summer while participating in the summer Day Camp programs. In order to provide engaging programs, it is important to outline essential aspects of safety with your children.

The following is a list of guidelines that all children in the program are expected to comply with:

- Respect for others and their property;
- Hands off;
- Aggressive/inappropriate behaviour is not permitted;
- Follow the instructions and listen to the camp staff;
- Stay with the group;
- Respect the safety of all participants.

If these rules are broken, the consequences will be as follows:

1. A verbal warning will be given to the child.
2. The parents will be contacted. The child and parents must then complete the Three-Way Communication Form regarding the situation.
3. If improper actions persist, counsellors have the authority to separate the camper from the rest of the group, and/or contact the parents to come and pick up the child. Supervisory Staff also reserve the right to ask that the child not return to camp if his/her actions are putting themselves and other campers in an unsafe environment. One of the persons on the pick-up permission form must be available for communication regarding the child's behaviour as parents/guardians may be required to pick their child up from camp at any point during the day if their behaviour does not comply with these standards.

PLEASE NOTE: in the instance of serious/malicious physical aggression towards another camper, patron, or staff member, step 3 will be implemented immediately.

If your child is removed from the camp due to safety concerns, a refund will not be given. Please go over these rules with your child(ren) to make sure that they are understood. Please sign and return this contract to the camp counsellors.
